HOW TO STORE YOUR SKIS PROPERLY AFTER WINTER

Interviewer: What's the first step in storing skis?

Wolfi: First, you should clean them thoroughly. Dirt, salt, and old wax residues can damage the base and edges.

Interviewer: What about the edges? They can rust, right?

Wolfi: Exactly! That's why it's important to check for rust spots and remove them with a file or a sharpening stone.

Interviewer: Should the base be treated as well?

Wolfi: Absolutely! A thick layer of hot wax protects the base from drying out. Unlike regular waxing, this time you don't scrape it off. Instead, leave the wax on until next season. Before your first run, you can scrape and polish it.

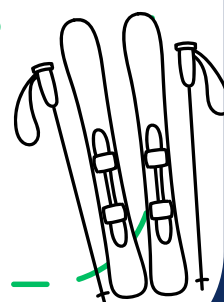
Interviewer: Where should skis be stored?

Wolfi: The storage location is crucial. Skis should be kept in a dry, cool place—but not too hot. A dry basement or a cool attic is ideal. Never store them in direct sunlight or near a heater, as heat can damage the materials.

Interviewer: Should they be stored lying down or standing up?

Wolfi: Either way works, as long as they are not under pressure. Some people store them flat on a shelf, while others stand them upright against a wall. Just make sure they're not squeezed under heavy objects or subjected to stress.

60 YEARS ANNIVERSARY "THE BEATLES - HELP!" IN OBERTAUERN
