Summer season of the Ski Jumping World Cup in Courchevel (1/2)



Courchevel is not just a winter destination.

Summer activities include walking, hiking, cycling, mountain and e-biking, with lakes and peaks to enjoy as well as festivals, fiestas, restaurants, mountain refuges and not to forget relaxation and wellness.

Some traditional winter activities continue and thrive in summer. For example, on 8 and 9 August this year, Courchevel Le Praz hosted the only French stage of the Ski Jumping World Cup, the "Summer Grand Prix". More than 100 athletes representing 20 countries took part supported by spectators and enthusiasts. As well as the women's and men's ski jumping competitions, there were air shows featuring the French Air Force's "Aerobatic" team and the "Rafale Solo Display", as well as a concert.



This event marked a historic 35th and final edition, before the venue undergoes modernisation work in preparation for the 2030 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games, building on the legacy of the 1992 Albertville Olympic Games. Having always been maintained with the greatest care, the springboards are now set to embark on a new chapter.

Some of the most beautiful pages in Courchevel's ski jumping history have been written by Olympic champions and World Cup winners. Masahiko Harada of Japan, Simon Ammann of Switzerland, Thomas Morgenstern and Stefan Kraft of Austria, and Kamil Stoch of Poland are among the prestigious winners who have left their mark on the Praz site. Stoch is the current co-holder of the springboard record with a jump of 137 metres, alongside Michael Hayböck and Daniel Tschofenig of Austria. Courchevel has also established itself as a world leader in women's ski jumping since its introduction in 2006. Notable athletes include Sara Takanashi, who holds the record for the most World Cup victories, including multiple victories in Courchevel, as well as Marita Kramer, Katharina Althaus, Nika Križnar and Nika Prevc, the 2025–26 World Cup overall winner. These athletes have all contributed to the sporting reputation of the Courchevel Grand Prix.



Summer season of the Ski Jumping World Cup in Courchevel (2/2)

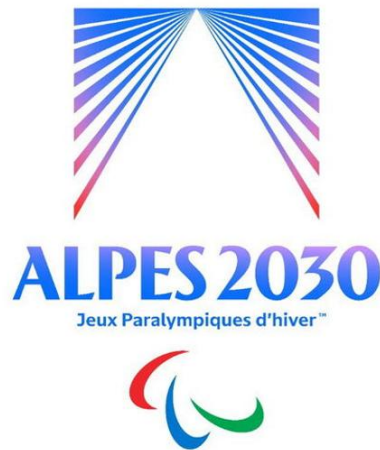
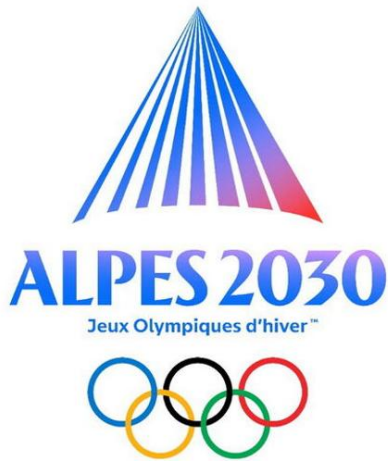


The competitions took place on the HS132 Olympic large hill in Courchevel Le Praz. This is frequently used for the FIS Summer Grand Prix, enabling the world's top specialists to compete in conditions similar to those experienced in the winter season, thanks to its synthetic surface.

The results of the Courchevel 2026 Summer Ski Jumping Grand Prix are as follows:

- In the men's event, Daniel Tschofenig of Austria won with 271.8 points, ahead of Philipp Raimund of Germany with 270.1 points and Naoki Nakamura of Japan with 267.8 points. Frenchman Valentin Foubert finished 11th.
- In the women's event, the Norwegians dominated — Anna Odine Strøm won with 241.1 points, Ingvild Synnøve Midtskogen came third with 220.4 points, and Yuki Ito of Japan came second with 226.9 points. Joséphine Pagnier came 7th for France.

Olympic Winter Games 2030



The 2030 Olympic Winter Games will take place from the 1st to the 17th of February 2030, followed by the Paralympic Games from the 1st to the 10th of March 2030, both in the French Alps.

Courchevel, in the Savoie department, offering world-class conditions and recognized as one of most prestigious ski resorts in France, will host the downhill events for alpine skiing, the Nordic combined skiing events and the ski jumping events. Courchevel will also host the para-alpine and para-snowboard events.

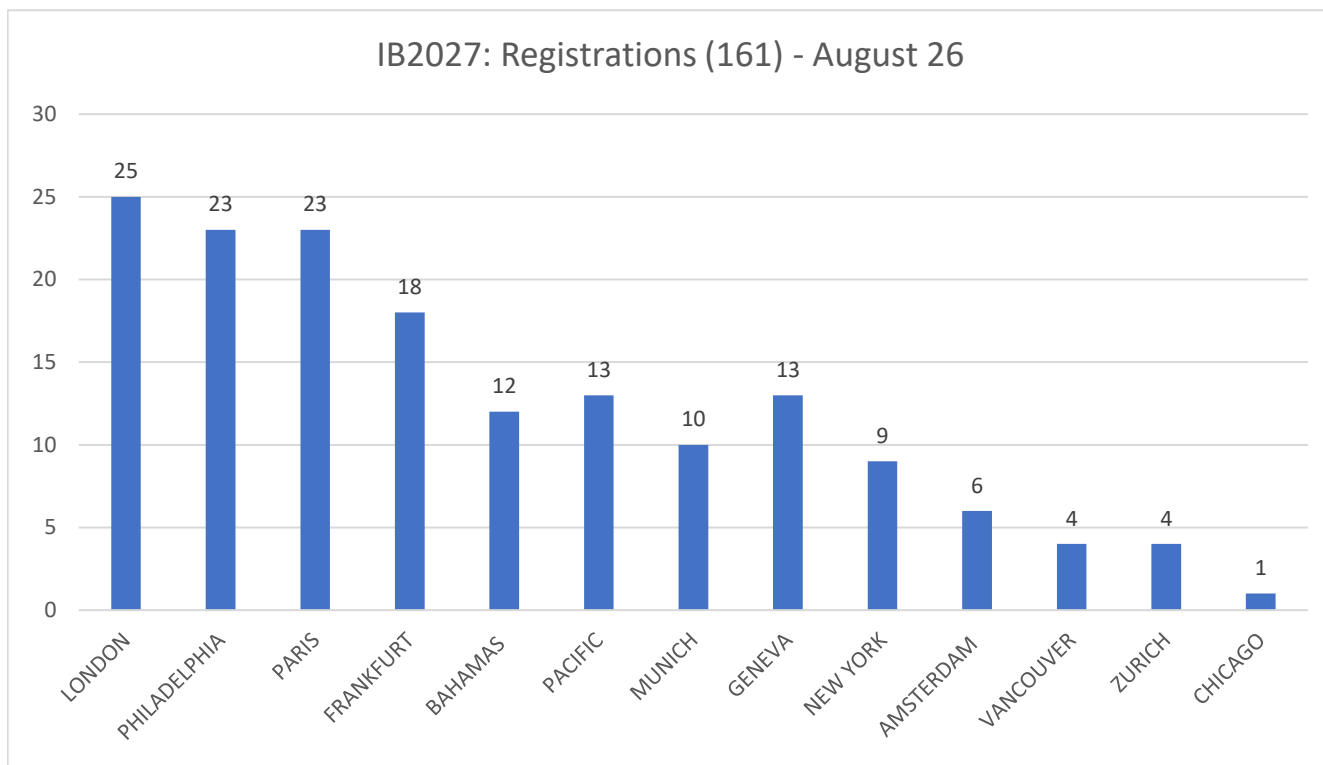

IB2027 Registrations: Status

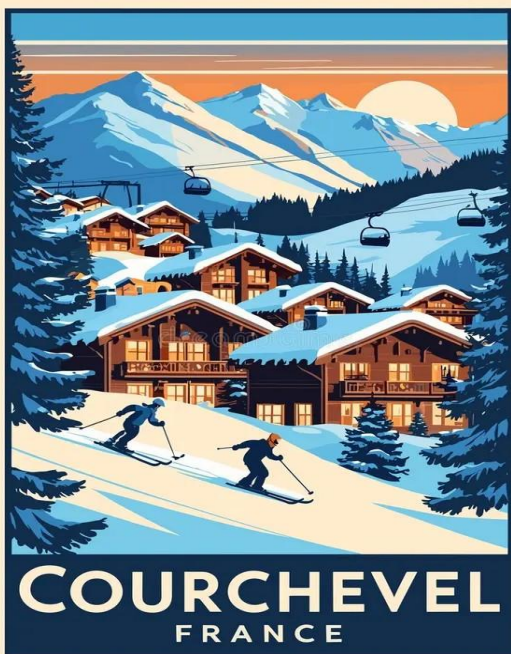
